These tests are not races or competitions - they are measures of what students know and what instruction we need to focus on as a school.

All students in K-5 take Math and Reading NWEA in April/May. They take this in the fall and winter too. Students in 3rd and 4th grades take Math and ELA M-Step in April or May. Our 5th graders will take a Math and ELA as well as a Science and Social Studies M-Step.
